The Arts Building at the University of St. Andrews is a brand new, state of the art and purpose designed international conference venue. It provides a 'real life' conference experience perfect for both postgraduate students presenting their work for the first time, and more experienced presenters.

All parallel sessions – along with morning and afternoon coffee – will be hosted here. In addition to accommodation and breakfast (if selected), as well as morning and afternoon coffee and the use of the venue itself, your attendance fees will also include a buffet lunch on all three days and, on Tuesday, a wine reception hosted by the University of St. Andrews Department of Geography and Geosciences.
