Joint LLM in International Commercial Law Study at Dundee Law School and the University of Cergy Pontoise, France



An exciting venture which brings together two dynamic and highly rated law schools.

The Joint Masters is an exciting venture which brings together two dynamic and highly rated law schools. Students will be taught through English by acknowledged experts and will gain an in depth knowledge of a wide range of contemporary commercial law subjects from both a common law and civil law perspective. The Joint Masters is a very challenging programme requiring students to adapt quickly to contrasting legal systems and modes of study.

Students enrolled on the dual qualifying LLM will graduate with a LLM in International Commercial Law from DLS and an LLM in Business & Taxation Law or Law & Business Ethics from University of Cergy-Pontoise [UCP].

Syllabus

The autumn semester will be spent in Scotland where, after a week long induction session, students will select two modules from the International Commercial Law programme

Semester 1	
International Business Transactions I	Principles of International E-Commerce
Problems in International Commercial Litigation	Principles of International Contract Law

For the spring semester students will go to Cergy-Pontoise, 30 minutes from the centre of Paris, and enrol in either the Business and Taxation Law Master or the Master in Law & Business Ethics. Students must complete four modules, taught through English, including options in:

Semester 2	
International Business Transactions II	International Insolvency Law
International Dispute Resolution	World Trade Organisation
Principles of International Insurance Law	

On completion of the second semester in June, students will return to Dundee for the summer semester to complete a 15,000 word **dissertation** on a comparative commercial law topic. The dissertation will be submitted by mid-August.
