



# 2012 Scottish Junior Legal Researchers Colloquium

## Call for Papers

We are pleased to announce that the **third Scottish Junior Legal Researchers Colloquium** will be hosted by the School of Law at the University of Dundee. This event will take place on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> April 2012 and is aimed at those undertaking postgraduate research in the area of law broadly defined.

The purpose of this Colloquium is to provide junior legal researchers with a platform to present a paper in an academic setting as well as discuss the themes involved with peers and receive feedback on their research. In particular, it is intended to offer the opportunity for junior researchers to meet one another and to share expertise and research experience. The Colloquium will also include a research and academic careers session with advice on publishing and thesis completion.

This one day event welcomes paper proposals in the field of law from postgraduate researchers located in Scotland, the rest of the United Kingdom and beyond. We particularly welcome papers in the following areas: public law, socio-legal studies, criminal justice, environmental law, public and private international law, international trade law, competition law, company and commercial law, human rights, criminal law, private law, legal theory, European law, medical law, intellectual property, constitutional and administrative law, family law, property and land law, freedom of information and alternative dispute resolution. We also welcome papers outside of these fields with a legal nexus. Papers will be streamed thematically.

If you wish to give a paper at the Colloquium, please submit an abstract of a maximum of 300 words outlining your proposal by Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2012. Submissions should be accompanied by four key words as well as a short biography of the author. Notification will be given to successful applicants within a fortnight.
