**Keir McAndrew, who is seconded from the Scottish Environment Protection Agency (SEPA) to the European Commission as a Detached National Expert providing advice on the proposed Industrial Emissions (Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control) Directive ('the IED'), will be visiting Dundee University on 13 May. Keir, who is a graduate from the University of Dundee, has been working in Brussels for the last three years and has been heavily involved in the drafting and negotiation of EU legislation on industrial emissions. This seminar will provide an insight into the way in which policy is formulated at a European level and the way in which its implementation is monitored.**

**The timing of the visit makes this particularly relevant, following the recent vote on the current proposals in the European Parliament's Committee on Environment, Public Health and Food Safety on the 4 May.**

**Following Keir's presentation there will be an opportunity to discuss specific issues regarding the European legislative process.**
