Masters (LLM) Water Governance and Conflict Resolution

The LLM Water Governance and Conflict Resolution is one of two LLM programmes delivered by the IHP-HELP Centre for Water Law, Policy & Science under the auspices of UNESCO. It is delivered in collaboration with our partners at UNESCO IHE - Delft, Netherlands. Students take courses in the Netherlands and Scotland.

The programme starts in Delft from October to May, studying water resources and also conflict management, delivered by staff from UNESCO Paris who run UNESCO's PCCP programme - from Potential Conflict to Cooperation Potential. Students then come to Dundee to participate in our summer graduate school, following the three core areas of water law - international water law, comparative national water law, and the regulation of water services - within a wider group of students and external participants. As a final step to the programme students then complete a dissertation or internship in Dundee or from a distance (as agreed).

This programme is available to students from law or non-law backgrounds. It is a unique opportunity for students from a law, policy or social science background to study the technical aspects of water resource management as well as conflict management and an in-depth overview of water law.

Course content

- Water resources, water governance and water management
- Water economics, water and environmental law
- Mediation and conflict management
- International water law - the rules applicable to transboundary water resources
- Comparative national water law - the management of water resources within a state
- Regulation of water services - the ownership and regulation of this essential service
- Options of a dissertation or internship

To apply

- Normally, a good Honours degree in a relevant discipline
- IELTS 6.5 or equivalent for applicants whose first language is not English

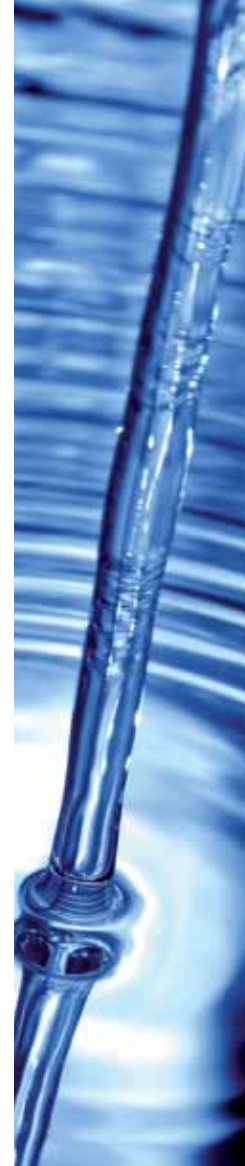
