Global Excellence Scholarship 2023/4: Key Facts Document/Terms & Conditions

This Key Facts Document sets out the main details of the Scholarship, as at date of publication.

Date of publication	September 2022, applicable to 2023/4 academic year (September 2023 or January 2024 entry)
Application Process	There is no separate application form for the Global Excellence Scholarship.
	The University of Dundee Admissions Team will use all information on an applicant's Course application to determine if they meet the eligibility criteria.
	 This verification process will happen at the initial Offer Stage. Where an applicant has 'pending' academic achievements at point of Offer, the University will not be able to confirm the scholarship until academic achievements have been submitted and verified. Where an applicant does not meet the criteria for this scholarship, the University may inform the applicant of other scholarships available.
Who is eligible?	 All applicants must: 1. Hold an offer to study an eligible Undergraduate or Postgraduate Taught course at the University of Dundee:
	 Undergraduate - Must hold an offer for a full time, on campus course - this excludes any course in the School of Medicine or Dentistry. Note: The course must be 120 credits
	 Postgraduate taught - Must hold an offer for a full time, on campus course in any academic school. Note the course must be 180 credits, apart from PGDip in Professional Legal Practice. Master of Research and Masters by Research Courses are covered by this
	scholarship. 2. Have achieved:
	 Undergraduate - UK BBB A-Level or above (or equivalent). Postgraduate Taught - UK 1st Class degree (or equivalent). UK Equivalencies of all Academic Qualifications are at the discretion of the
	 University of Dundee. 3. Be classified as an International Fee-paying student by the University of Dundee. 4. Not be studying a PhD Course. 5. Have a Course tuition fee of £19,600.
	 Have a Course tuition fee of £19,600. NB: Any course which does not have a fee of this value, or above, will not be considered for this award.
Scholarship Information	 The value of this scholarship is £6,000 and is awarded as a tuition fee waiver. No direct payment is made to any applicant. The scholarship is paid in each year of applicable study:
	 a. Undergraduate applicants can receive the scholarship for up to 5 years of progressing study. (£30,000 over 5 years). b. Where the course is a 3.5-year Undergraduate Degree (School of Business) then the scholarship will only be applied in Year 2 onwards.
	c. Postgraduate Taught applicants (including Master of Research and Masters by Research) - where the course spans more than 12 months full time, and a full year tuition fee is due in each academic year, then the scholarship can be applied in both years of study.

	3. Scholarships are awarded on an Unconditional basis. However, this is not linked to the
	Course application status.
	4. Scholarships cannot be awarded on a pro-rata basis.
Key Information	1. This scholarship is applicable to the entry year to the University of Dundee only and cannot be backdated to previous years. The University will not offer a scholarship to
	 students who have matriculated at the University onto the programme of study. Applicants are unable to combine the Global Excellence scholarship with: a. Any other University of Dundee scholarship, except for the University of Dundee Alumni Scholarship. If an applicant is eligible for both scholarships, they can be combined to a maximum of £9,000. b. Any externally, partially funded scholarship. If the external scholarship is
	lower than the Global Excellence scholarship, then the applicant must select an applicable scholarship.
	 c. If the applicant holds a fully funded external scholarship, the Global Excellence Scholarship will be removed as all tuition fees are covered. The University will not provide the Global Excellence Scholarship as an additional award.
	 3. Should an applicant wish to defer their entry to the University of Dundee, the following rule applies: a. Deferral within the same academic year: Scholarship can also be deferred.
	b. Deferral to a new academic year: Scholarship cannot be deferred.4. Clearing applicants are eligible to receive this scholarship, and eligibility will be
	 assessed as above. 5. International College Dundee applicants are eligible to receive this scholarship in the entry year to the main Degree at the University of Dundee.
	 6. If an applicant changes Course before, during or after matriculation, the University reserves the right to re-assess eligibility for scholarships and may retract the Scholarship Offer should an applicant's eligibility have changed.
	7. If an applicant changes Fee status or any other personal information before, during or after matriculation, the University reserves the right to re-assess eligibility for scholarships and may retract the Scholarship Offer should an applicant's eligibility have changed.
	8. If an applicant has paid their tuition fees in full prior to being awarded the Global Excellence Scholarship, the value of the scholarship will be refunded to the applicant after they have enrolled at the University of Dundee. Alternatively, this can be transferred to the University accommodation account balance (if applicable).
	9. The scholarship is only paid to applicants in the years in which full tuition fees are paid. This applies to applicant who may study abroad during their Undergraduate studies. The University of Dundee fees department will confirm the status of the scholarship where required.
	 10. All communication with the student will be via email, and to the @dundee.ac.uk email address. We may also communicate with other email addresses provided to us by the applicant. Types of communication may be: a. Confirming the scholarship;
	 Informing the applicant that they have not met the criteria to be awarded the scholarship.
	 c. Requesting further information. 11. We are unable to disclose details of the scholarship to anyone other than the applicant unless consent is given to do so.
	 12. Should a student withdraw from programme of study, the University Fees department may be in contact regarding payment of fees and scholarship balance.
	13. All scholarship decisions are final and cannot be appealed.
