Emily Travis Scholarship 2024-25 (the "Scholarship")

Key Facts Document

This Key Facts Document sets out the main details of the Scholarship, as at date of publication. This document should be reviewed alongside the <u>University of Dundee Scholarship Terms and Conditions</u>, as those terms and conditions will provide you with additional information that apply to you in respect of the Scholarship.

Date of publication	October 2023, applicable to 2024/5 academic year (September 2024 or January 2025 entry).
Application Process	 Application form Eligible applicants must submit an application for Emily Travis Scholarship, using the University of Dundee application link via www.dundee.ac.uk/scholarships. Applicants with an offer to study the Science and Healthcare Communications MSc should submit a short (500-700 word) application letter, outlining the benefits of health communications from a patient perspective/benefit. All applications are reviewed by a panel of university staff and selection is based on quality of personal statement. Only applications which pass the eligibility criteria will be reviewed, all other applications will be rejected, and the applicant notified. All decisions are communicated with an applicant, whether successful or unsuccessful. Please note that the eligibility is assessed at the time of the application and will not be re-evaluated post matriculation. If an applicant changes course before, during or after matriculation, the University of Dundee reserves the right to retract the scholarship offer should an applicant's eligibility have changed.
Who is eligible?	 You must have either a conditional or unconditional offer to study the Science and Healthcare Communications MSc for September 2024. Hold 'Home Scottish'/'Home Rest of UK' Fee Status.
Award Information	 The value of this scholarship is £10,000. This award will be used to cover the programme fees for a home/UK student The scholarship is paid in the year of applicable study



Key Information

- 1. The programme must be a 12-month, full time programme. If the programme is less than 12 months then the applicant is **not** eligible for the scholarship.
- 2. If the applicant has applied for a Part Time or Distance Learning programme, then they are **not** eligible for this scholarship.
- 3. Applicants holding an external scholarship:
 - Applicants with a fully funded external scholarship, covering the full amount
 of tuition fees due to the University, will not be awarded this scholarship as
 the total combined of both awards will exceed the tuition fee total.
 - If the external scholarship only provides the applicant with partial funding, then this Scholarship can still be applied up to the maximum tuition fee balance.
- 4. The University reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship immediately and without notice where the student is determined by the University to have misled the University about any aspect of eligibility to receive the scholarship.
- 5. If the student withdraws from the programme, they must notify the Registry Team that they are no longer enrolled at the University of Dundee.
- 6. The University of Dundee will not backdate any awards, and all awards made will be current and apply to the student pre matriculation only.
