The terms and conditions for the Rest of UK Academic Excellence Scholarship, Discover Dundee (RUK) Scholarship, Discover Nursing (RUK) at Dundee and the Rest of UK Bursary offered to students in the academic year 2018/19 are as follows:

1 Terms and Conditions for all

You hereby acknowledge and agree that payment by the University of all instalments of the scholarship or bursary shall be made strictly subject to you having continued to make academic progress at the required level (2:1 for the entire academic year (or equivalent) and with no resits in any set examinations) on your programme of study to the University's satisfaction.

The decision as to whether you as an awardee are deemed to have made satisfactory progress on your programme of study to receive payment of any scholarship shall be made at the University's sole discretion.

The University reserves the right to withdraw your scholarship immediately and without notice to you where you are determined by the University to have misled the University about any aspect of your eligibility to receive your scholarship.

Under any such circumstances, the University shall be entitled to seek repayment of any portion of your scholarship which may already have been paid to you. You do not have to reapply annually for the scholarship.

2 Application

You do not need to complete an application form for any of the scholarships or bursaries. If you meet all the eligibility criteria you will be notified by October 2018 that you will receive the awards for which you are eligible.

3 Payment

The Discover Dundee (RUK) Scholarship, Rest of UK Bursary and Discover Nursing (RUK) at Dundee Scholarship will be paid in two instalments: at the end of November 2018 and the end of February 2019.

The Rest of UK Academic Excellence Scholarship will be paid in three instalments: at the end of November 2018, the end of February 2019 and the end of April 2019 in equal amounts. When you are notified of your eligibility for an award, you will also be given information about the process for receiving payment.

4 Eligibility for other University financial support

Students may be eligible for a number of RUK awards depending on individual circumstances. The Rest of UK Academic Excellence Scholarship may be held in conjunction with other University awards, such as the Discover Dundee (RUK) Scholarship and the Rest of UK Bursary.

The Discover Nursing at Dundee Scholarship cannot be held in conjunction with another RUK Scholarship, however students are eligible for either Discover Nursing at Dundee or Academic Excellence in Year 1. If you are awarded Academic Excellence in Year 1 and fail to meet progression criteria to obtain this award in Year 2, then you will still be eligible to receive the Discover Nursing at Dundee scholarship in Year 2.

Students facing financial difficulty at any time during their studies are encouraged to contact the Student Funding Unit.

5 Transferability

The Rest of UK Academic Excellence Scholarship is payable once for each level of your degree programme which is delivered at the University. You will continue to be eligible for the scholarship if you change your degree course, subject to meeting the conditions above.



6 Scholarship suspension

The Rest of UK Academic Excellence Scholarship, Discover Dundee (RUK) Scholarship and Discover Nursing (RUK) at Dundee will be suspended during a period of approved leave of absence (temporary withdrawal of studies) where this period covers a whole academic year, and may be reinstated on your return to fulltime study subject to the conditions above. The scholarship will also be suspended for periods of leave of absence that cover part of the academic year, and may be reinstated on your return to full-time study, subject to the conditions above. On your return to study you will be entitled to the balance of the scholarship for the level. There will be no payment for repeat periods of study in any circumstances.

The Rest of UK Bursary will be suspended if you withdraw from your course or if your household income changes and there is an over-payment of award.

7 Scholarship termination

If your academic progress is deemed to be unsatisfactory, or you no longer meet the eligibility criteria set out above, the University will terminate your scholarship or bursary, and you will no longer be eligible for the award in subsequent years. If you withdraw from your studies, or are required to withdraw, no further payments will be made. Your scholarship will be terminated if you cease to be registered as a student with the University, or for good cause at the discretion of the Dean of your School, or his/her nominee for this purpose.

8 Use of data

By accepting the scholarship, recipients are giving the University permission to use their details for promotional purposes and may be asked to provide a case study which may be used in University publications or on the website.

9 Dispute resolution

Acceptance of the Rest of UK Academic Excellence Scholarship, the Discover Dundee (RUK) Scholarship, Discover Nursing (RUK) at Dundee and the Rest of UK Bursary constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions.

Matriculated students should contact the Student Funding Unit in the first instance for guidance regarding this award. In cases not covered by the above terms and conditions, or where a student claims exceptional circumstances, or disputes a decision not to make payments due under a scholarship or bursary, the student should contact the Director of Student Services and will be considered through the Student Complaints procedure. Final appeals on decisions regarding eligibility must be made via the Student Complaints process (http://www.dundee.ac.uk/governance/dca/).
