

Rest of UK scholarships and bursaries 2019/20

We have a range of undergraduate scholarships and bursaries designed to help students classified as Rest of UK (RUK) fee status entering the University of Dundee for undergraduate study. Eligibility criteria for applicants entering for the first time in September 2019 are given below.

Academic Excellence Scholarship (the “Scholarship”)

Application Process	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There is no separate application for this scholarship, as our Admissions Team will automatically assess you for this scholarship based on the information provided in your course application. Confirmation of your award will be in writing, and may be as part of your offer letter. • If you believe you are eligible for this scholarship but have not received confirmation, please get in touch with our enquiry team on contactus@dundee.ac.uk. We will then review your record and confirm in writing if you are eligible. • We cannot accept late enquiries or applications for this scholarship after the deadline date, so please ensure all correspondence with the University is before the deadline date (01/10/2019)
Who can apply?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rest of UK (RUK) Fee Status Applicants, resident in the UK • Studying your first undergraduate degree in any of our Schools, excluding Medicine, Dentistry, or Education & Social Work. • Have entry qualifications of AAB at A-Level or above. If you do not have UK qualifications but meet the rest of the scholarship criteria, you can contact us to discuss entry equivalencies to confirm your eligibility. The grade equivalencies are set by the University. • You must be studying your first undergraduate degree, as you will not be eligible if you have transferred from another UK Higher Education institution or if you already have an undergraduate degree (from any University).
Selection Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you meet the above “who can apply?” criteria, then you will be automatically awarded this scholarship by our Admissions Team. • You must meet the academic conditions attached to your offer of entry to the University. • We will notify you by October 2019 if you are eligible to receive this scholarship.
Awards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The value of this scholarship is £3,000 per year of study. Payment in subsequent years is dependent on satisfactory progression, which is set and monitored by the University. This is an average of B3 across core modules with no re-sits. • You are only entitled to receive payment in the years in which you pay your tuition fees. For example, if you are on a 4 year programme but only pay tuition fees for 3 years, you are entitled to receive the scholarship for the 3 years of study. • The scholarship is made in 3 separate payments over the course of the academic year, usually the end of November 2019, end of February 2020 and end of April 2020. • Payment of the scholarship is made after you matriculate at the University of Dundee and completed by our Student Funding department. Details of how and when you will receive payment will be emailed to you by the end of October 2019.



Key Information

- All communication with you will be via email, and to your @dundee.ac.uk email address.
- If your programme permits, you may be eligible for the Academic Excellence Scholarship in addition to the Discover Dundee Scholarship and the RUK Bursary. We will confirm any multiple scholarship awards with you by communication, after we have verified your eligibility.
- If as part of your course you study one year abroad or a year in industry, you will not be eligible to receive payment during this time. However we will still monitor your progress, and payment will continue once you return to Dundee (subject to satisfactory progression).
- If you are a Nursing student, you are eligible for either Academic Excellence scholarship **or** The Discover Nursing at Dundee Scholarship, not both. If you are awarded the Academic Excellence scholarship in Year 1 but fail to meet progression criteria into Year 2, then you will be allocated the Discover Nursing at Dundee scholarship in subsequent years. Due to the semester dates for Nursing students, we will let you know by the end of October in the academic year if this applies to you.
- Payment of this scholarship will be suspended during a period of approved leave of absence (temporary withdrawal of studies) where this period covers a whole academic year, and may be reinstated on your return to fulltime study subject to the eligibility criteria still being met. The scholarship will also be suspended for periods of leave of absence that cover part of the academic year, and may be reinstated on your return to full-time study. On your return to study you will be entitled to the balance of the scholarship for the level. There will be no payment for repeat periods of study in any circumstances.
- If your academic progress is deemed to be unsatisfactory, or you no longer meet the eligibility criteria set out above, the University will terminate your scholarship or bursary, and you will no longer be eligible for the award in subsequent years. If you withdraw from your studies, or are required to withdraw, no further payments will be made. Your scholarship will be terminated if you cease to be registered as a student with the University, or for good cause at the discretion of the Dean of your School, or his/her nominee for this purpose.

Who can apply?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rest of UK (RUK) Fee Status Applicants, resident in the UK • Studying at undergraduate level for a BSc Nursing degree in the school of Nursing and Health Sciences. • Students enrolling with the University in the academic year 2019/20 for the first time.
Selection Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you meet the above “who can apply?” criteria, then you will be automatically awarded this scholarship by our Admissions Team. • You must meet the academic conditions attached to your offer of entry to the University. • We will notify you by October 2019 if you are eligible to receive this scholarship.
Awards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The value of this scholarship is £2,250 for the duration of your programme. • Payment in subsequent years is dependent on satisfactory progression, which is set and monitored by the University. • The scholarship is made in 2 separate payments over the course of the academic year, usually the end of November 2019 and the end of February 2020. • Payment of the scholarship is made after you matriculate at the University of Dundee and completed by our Student Funding department. Details of how and when you will receive payment will be emailed to you by the end of October 2019.
Key Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All communication with you will be via email, and to your @dundee.ac.uk email address. • Payment by the University of all instalments of this scholarship shall be made strictly subject to you having continued to make academic progress at the required level. Due to the semester dates for nursing students, we will let you know by the end of October in the academic year if your funding for the next year is confirmed. • The decision as to whether you as an awardee are deemed to have made satisfactory progress on your programme of study to receive payment of any scholarship shall be made at the University’s sole discretion.



- The University reserves the right to withdraw your scholarship immediately and without notice to you where you are determined by the University to have misled the University about any aspect of your eligibility to receive your scholarship.
- Under any such circumstances, the University shall be entitled to seek repayment of any portion of your scholarship which may already have been paid to you.
- You do not have to reapply annually for the scholarship.
- The Discover Nursing at Dundee Scholarship cannot be held in conjunction with another RUK Scholarship. However students are eligible for either Discover Nursing at Dundee or Academic Excellence in Year 1. If you are awarded Academic Excellence in Year 1 and fail to meet progression criteria to obtain this award in Year 2, then you will still be eligible to receive the Discover Nursing at Dundee scholarship in Year 2.
- Payment of this scholarship will be suspended during a period of approved leave of absence (temporary withdrawal of studies) where this period covers a whole academic year, and may be reinstated on your return to fulltime study subject to the eligibility criteria still being met. The scholarship will also be suspended for periods of leave of absence that cover part of the academic year, and may be reinstated on your return to full-time study. On your return to study you will be entitled to the balance of the scholarship for the level. There will be no payment for repeat periods of study in any circumstances.
- If you withdraw from your studies, or are required to withdraw, no further payments will be made. Your scholarship will be terminated if you cease to be registered as a student with the University, or for good cause at the discretion of the Dean of your School, or his/her nominee for this purpose.



University of Dundee Bursary

Rest of UK Bursary (the “Bursary”)

This Key Facts Document sets out the main details of the Bursary, as at date of publication

Application Process	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There is no separate application form for this bursary. • After you have matriculated at the University of Dundee, our Student Funding Department will receive confirmation from the Student Loans Company if your total household income (combined) is less than £20,000. We will then contact you to confirm your award, detailing how and when payment will be made. This will be by the end of November 2019. We will also contact throughout your studies if any of your details change or you no longer meet the criteria to be awarded this bursary.
Who can apply?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Matriculate at the University of Dundee for an undergraduate degree in any of our Schools excluding Nursing & Health Sciences; • Your annual household income must be less than £20,000 combined. This information is held by the Student Loans Company and accessed by the University. • Are classified as RUK Fee Status, which is confirmed in your Offer Letter from the University. You must also be resident in the UK
Selection Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Using the information received from the Student Loans Company, you will be selected to receive this award if you meet the above “who can apply?” criteria. • If your household income changes at any point throughout your studies, then we will reassess your eligibility and your bursary may be suspended. • You must also meet the academic conditions attached to your offer of entry to be awarded this bursary.
Awards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • £2,000 per year of study, paid in 2 installments over the academic year. This will usually be by the end of November 2019 and the end of February 2020. • You are only entitled to receive payment in the years in which you pay your tuition fees. For example, if you are on a 4 year programme but only pay tuition fees for 3 years, you are entitled to receive the scholarship for the 3 years of study. • Payment of the scholarship is made after you matriculate at the University of Dundee and completed by our Student Funding department. Details of how and when you will receive payment will be emailed to you by the end of October 2019.
Key Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All communication with you will be via email, and to your @dundee.ac.uk email address. • If we are unable to retrieve information from the Student Loans Company to verify your household income, then we cannot allocate you this award. You need to ensure that you have arranged ‘consent to share’ for your household income details, for bursary purposes, with your funding body to ensure the University can access this information and assess your eligibility.



- The decision as to whether you as an awardee are deemed to have made satisfactory progress on your programme of study to receive payment of any scholarship shall be made at the University's sole discretion.
- The University reserves the right to withdraw your bursary immediately and without notice to you where you are determined by the University to have misled the University about any aspect of your eligibility to receive your bursary.
- Under any such circumstances, the University shall be entitled to seek repayment of any portion of your bursary which may already have been paid to you. You do not have to reapply annually for the bursary.
- Payment in subsequent years is dependent on your household income and if it increases to above £20,000, then you will not be eligible to receive funding.
- The RUK Bursary can be help in conjunction with other awards, for example the Academic Excellence Scholarship and/or Discover Dundee Scholarship.
- The RUK Bursary will be suspended if you withdraw from your course or if your household income changes and there is an over-payment of award.
