The SRC is the oldest student voice forum at the University and is the democratic membership body of the Students' Association.

Membership of the Council is made up of eight main groups/positions:


1. Independent Chair
2. Elected councillors with individual remits/portfolios
3. School Presidents
4. DUSA Executive
5. Student Halls Representative
6. Independent Member of Court
7. Rector or the Rectors Assessor and
8. Sports Union President

The group is convened by DUSA's Vice President of Representation across the academic year and plays a vital role in:

- Engaging the student body in activities which enhance the university experience
- Develop, recommend and work on campaigns, policies and other related projects which support improvements at the university and DUSA
- Jointly pass amendments to DUSA's governance documentation such as the constitution and bye-laws
