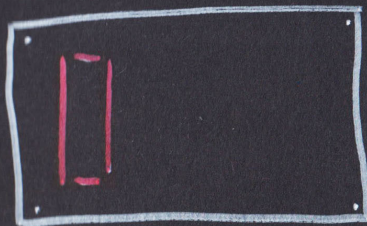


'DATA-DOUBLE' + CONCEPT FOR WORK WITH

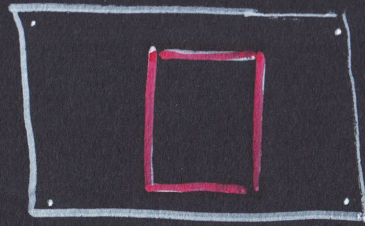
'Data double' -
